1. Introduction

Congratulations on selecting the **BiANCO NXT iAlarm**. Supplied pre-wired as a standalone 'plug and play' level alarm which provides visual and audible alarm warnings.

The display screen identifies the unit state and the unit can be changed between operating as a high level or a low level alarm at the press of a button.



3. Operation

Plug the alarm into a power point and turn the alarm on.

Power supply should be through an isolating transformer or RCD having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30mA

Press and Hold the MODE button for 5 seconds to change between HIGH-LEVEL alarm mode OR LOW-LEVEL alarm mode. The light will flash when the unit is in an alarm state. Pressing the mute button silences the audible alarm, the light continues to flash.



A short press of the MUTE button silences the audible alarm.

A short press of the PULSE button switches between continuous and intermittent audible alarm state.

4. Installation


The **NXT iAlarm** has an I.P.54 rating.

Consider additional protection against adverse weather where appropriate.

Using suitably rated cable, the float can be extended up to a total of 50m length.



The main internal printed circuit board is clearly labelled. Only suitably qualified personnel should alter the 240V circuit wiring.




The power flex and float cable should never be encased in metal piping / conduit.

The 10m float cable is supplied with a counterweight.

In situations where the float switch cable is not secured to a fixed object i.e. the float is lowered freely into the tank, a counterweight is necessary to ensure correct operation by providing a pivot point for the float.

Exercise care in positioning the float to ensure it cannot become snagged or otherwise rendered inoperable.



5. Misc

The **NXT iAlarm** is an alarm module ONLY.

It does not and cannot operate a pump.

There is no ability to connect to any network or to trigger external devices including remote alarm units.

The **NXT-iAlarm** meets the requirements of AS/NZS 1546 - On-site domestic wastewater treatment units.
