 DAMS AND DRAINAGE SYSTEMS




IT'S TIME TO STOP CANE TOADS TAKING OVER AUSTRALIA



Trapping adult toads is slow work BUT thousands of tadpoles can be caught with a single tadpole trap!

- A lure has been scientifically developed that attracts Cane Toad tadpoles
- The lure tempts tadpoles into a trap so they can be easily removed from the water
- Native frog tadpoles are not interested in the lure, reducing the risk of bi-catch
- The lure is non-toxic and doesn't impact other species
- Thousands of tadpoles can be caught in one trapping session


