4mm and 13mm ID Tube

Drip Eze is available in 4mm and 13mm tube to suit a variety of landscape applications. Use with Australian standard poly fittings.

Classic & Pressure Compensating

Select from classic (NPC) or pressure compensating (PC) tube to suit the landscape requirements. PC provides even water application over steep and undulating terrain and allows for longer runs.

1.6 Lph, 2 Lph and 8 Lph Flow Rates

Drip Eze applies water slowly to penetrate the root zone. Select from a range of spacings to suit your requirements.

Clog minimisation

Two directly opposed outlet holes minimise chance of clogging.

Visible Emitter

The clearly visible emitter is easily aligned with plants for targeted watering and can be avoided when cutting through the tube, making it easier to insert the poly fittings.

13mm lilac tubing for use with non-potable water. Available in classic and pressure compensating. Marked "Caution not for drinking"

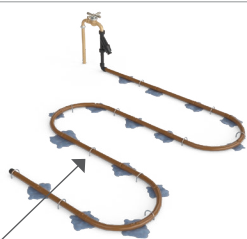
Quickdrip™



Ideal for sandy soils and high density plantings, high flow 8 Lph classic drip tubing.

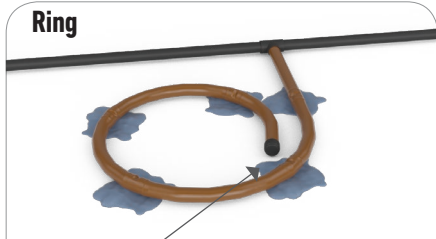
TYPICAL INSTALLATION METHODS

Snake



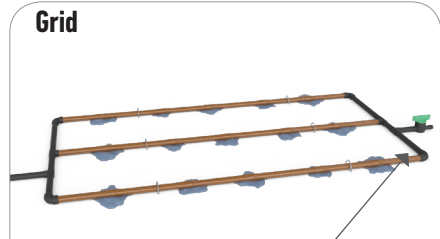
Use hold down stakes to keep the Drip Eze in place.

Ring



Use a 13mm End Plug to seal the end of the Drip Eze.

Grid



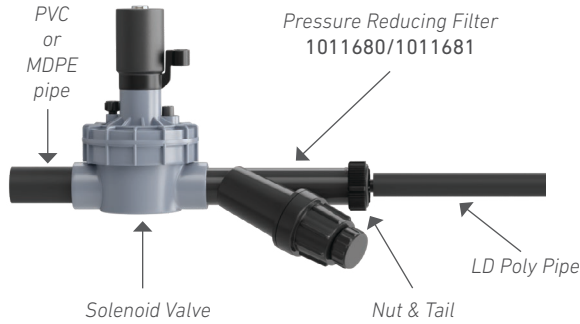
Adding an in-line tap allows you to flush the lines.

TIP: Flush the Drip Eze before 1st use to clear any debris that may have entered the tube during installation.

CONNECTION TO THE WATER SUPPLY

Automatic

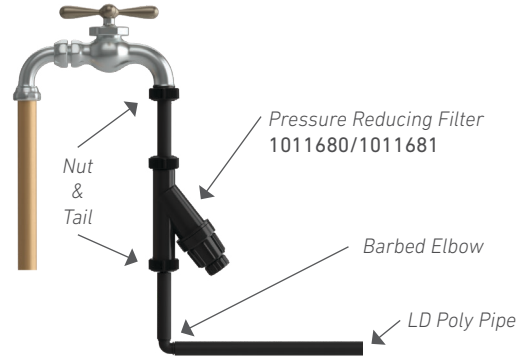
Connect Drip Eze line to home irrigation system for automated watering.



Irrigation controller turns Drip Eze on and off.

Manual

Turn Drip Eze system on and off from the garden tap.



Connect a manual or automatic tap timer to the tap, for greater watering control.

For best results, connections should always be secured with locking clamps.
